Sealed tenders are hereby invited for the fruits of Mango (1750 no. of trees of different ages & variety) orchards at State Horticultural Research and Development Station, Krishnagar, Nadia for two consecutive years i.e. 2012 - 13 & 2013 - 14. Interested tenderer can offer price observing the following terms & conditions strictly:

Terms & Conditions:

1. Superscribe the sealed envelope containing tender as "Tender for fruits of mango orchards for 2012 - 13 & 2013 - 14 fruiting seasons" addressed to the Horticulturist, Krishnagar, State Horticultural Research and Development Station, Nadia with an **Open Demand Draft** of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) only as earnest money **in favour of Fruit Bio - Chemist, Krishnagar in any nationalized bank payable at Krishnagar**. Tender without the requisite earnest money will stand invalid and summarily be cancelled.
2. The earnest money of the successful tenderer will only be retained as Security Deposit and the same will be returned back after satisfactory completion of the tender period. The Security Deposit will be forfeited if any damage to Govt. property is caused due to the successful tenderer during the tender period.
3. Rate should be quoted both in figure and words.
4. The Tenderer may observe the condition of the orchard after taking permission from the Horticulturist, Krishnagar, State Horticultural Research & Development Station, Krishnagar, Nadia during office hours.
5. Tender can be submitted duly at the tender box kept at office of the Horticulturist, Krishnagar, State Horticultural Research and Development Station, Krishnagar, Nadia from 11.00 am to 03.00 pm at working days..
6. The last date of receiving tender is 08.03.2013 up to 1.00 pm at the Office of the Horticulturist, Krishnagar, State Horticultural Research & Development Station, Krishnagar, Nadia. The tender will be duly opened on the same day (08.03.2013) at 2.00 pm. The last date of accepting tender and the date of opening may be shifted to the next working day in unavoidable circumstances.
7. The rate should be quoted above Rs. 5, 50,000.00 (Rupees Five Lakh Fifty Thousand) only for the said tender of orchard for two years. Tender quoting rate below Rs. 5, 50,000.00 will not be treated as valid.
8. The successful tenderer must deposit 50% of his offered price through **Open Demand Draft in favour of Fruit Bio - Chemist, Krishnagar in any nationalized bank payable at Krishnagar**, on the next working day of the date of opening the tender within 3.00 pm
9. The balance amount (50%) of the approved rate of successful tenderer should be deposited within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of opening of tender positively through **Open Demand Draft in favour of Fruit Bio - Chemist, Krishnagar in any nationalized bank payable at Krishnagar**.
10. The successful tenderer can collect the fruits of mango orchard up to 31.07.2014.
11. Excepting the availability of live saving irrigation water at the farm, successful tenderer has to make his own arrangement for security, access of necessary equipments & implements, inputs required, etc for satisfactory maintenance of the Govt. orchard during the tender period.
12. Branches of any fruit tree of the tendered Mango orchard can be utilized as scion or for any other propagation work for the interest of the Govt. farm during the tender period. Pruning and training will also be done if required for maintenance of the orchard during the tender period.
13. In case the successful tenderer does not finally agree to pay the rate approved by the tender Committee and accept the orchard as per the terms & conditions, the security deposit of that tenderer will be forfeited.
14. Authority will bear no responsibility for any damage caused to fruit/ tree due to any natural calamity.
15. Authority can impose any condition if required at any stage of the tender.
16. The authority reserves the right to accept / reject the tender without mentioning any reason thereof at any stage deemed fit by it.
17. No Govt. Servent should be allowed to submit tender; otherwise, the earnest money/security deposit of that tender will be forfeited.
